A red asterix (*) indicates tags or attributes, that do **not** follow the HTML 3.2 (Wilbur) standard. These (few) elements are included, because they are supported by the two major browsers: Netscape Navigator & Microsoft Internet Explorer. No other browser specific tags and attributes are included.

Font Face is **not** a HTML 3.2 standard, and how the text looks, depends on which fonts your Operating System chooses to use as substitutes for the fonts, if the specified fonts are not available.

Basefont face: Arial

This is the Default alignment of an image.








Image Maps




The image to the left is Mapped. If you click on one of the three figures or on the background in the upper two thirds of the image, your browser should jump to the corresponding figure below. Because the figures and their anchors below are placed in a table, not all browsers are able to find the figures.

Not all browsers supports the SHAPE=DEFAULT* attribute in the <AREA> tag, and will therefore not jump to this Figure.
Click on the Figure to jump back to the Image Map.



Click on the Circle to jump back to the Image Map.

Click on the Rectangle to jump back to the Image Map.



Click on the Triangle to jump back to the Image Map.


